#### Medical Mission

Medical teams are making trips several times a year, seeing 2000 or more patients with each trip. In addition to the clinics being done in Haiti, many children have been selected for surgery back in the United States. Four children are currently scheduled to begin surgeries in early 2004 and many more are on the way. Please keep these families in prayer as they go through this trying time. Especially, we ask for your prayers for those who are not eligible for surgery due to the advanced stage of their diseases. During this most recent medical trip, with Florida Station Church of God, many patients with late stages of

cancer came to the clinics seeking help which, unfortunately is beyond our capabilities. We are challenged and blessed by these encounters as we entrust them to the Lord for healing.
