Having pioneered the home for children, and cared for them directly since its beginning, this will be a difficult transition for her and we ask your prayers for her and the children during these coming months.

Home for Children

Beginning this August first, Dennis and Megan McDaniel will assume the role of directors for the home

for children. Dennis and Megan come from Southern Indiana where they are being commissioned by New Creations Ministries. We offer our prayers and assistance to them in their efforts to care for the children we have come to know and love from years of visiting the home in Haiti. Mission Haiti, Inc (Asheville, NC) continues to oversee the child sponsorships for the home.

Upcoming Mission Trips

To allow for more privacy and space, Mission Haiti, Inc - Midwest will no longer be lodging at the home for children. Alternate lodging is being arranged. Semi Shipments

Another valuable aspect of our ministry is the shipment of goods and donations to Haiti in semi-trailers. We have been blessed to be able to offer space for other ministries, including the McDaniel's, for the greater good of Haiti. We are pleased to announce the recent shipment of such a trailer this July and we are grateful to all of those who were able to help out with the loading efforts.

Operation Rosie

An affiliate of Mission Haiti, Inc - Midwest, Operation Rosie is growing and changing the lives of young Haitian children through the miracle of surgery. Currently there are 3 children in the United States preparing to undergo life-saving surgery through Operation Rosie. Fifteen surgeries have already been provided to 11 different children.

With the continued generosity of hospitals, doctors, surgeons and host-families, Operation Rosie hopes to reach out to more children, still awaiting surgery in Haiti.

Hospital Update

On July 11, 2005 the doors of the Hospital in Sainthard were opened to the general public as an ongoing outpatient clinic. Having served as a clinic during mission trips, the facility will now operate throughout the year, staffed by 2 Haitian MDs, 2 LPNs and a Medical Director, Dr. Ernst Pady.

Pastor Jean Marie Louis Jean has agreed to oversee the financial operations of the hospital. Operating costs are calculated at \$4,000/month including salaries, medications, supplies and maintenance.



Monthly commitments to Mission Haiti Midwest currently total approximately \$2,000 per month. For continued operation of the hospital, we will need to double our monthly incoming contributions. Please prayerfully consider making a monthly commitment to support the work of Mission Haiti, Inc - Midwest.
