Clinic Update

As always, the staff of the clinic in Sainthard, in conjunction with the Medical Advisory Committee in Anderson is always looking for ways to expand the services we provide at a cost effective and easily-accessible method. With the assistance of the Lions Club and the generosity of Dr. Robert McCurdy, we now have 5,000 prescription eye-glasses and a project in motion to provide quality vision care as part of the clinic operations. Dr. Ernst Pady, Medical Director for the clinic is currently recruiting an optometrist to serve at the clinic on a regular basis.

The staff has requested a spectrophotometer to perform blood chemistries, as well as a sonogram machine for diagnosing and treating more complex disorders. Work is underway to expand radiology services as well. With the next
