While the crowds are a welcomed sight to the staff of the clinic, it is going to be a long day seeing patients. So, too, the clinic is a welcomed sight for the hundreds who make this journey every week. Not long ago, such medical care didn't exist in this area. The clinic, facilitated by Mission Haiti, Inc - Midwest continues to grow as we respond to the needs of the community. The staff is anxious to expand the services we can provide to the community and we are thrilled to announce the addition of an on-site laboratory and dental clinic. The new lab will be able to provide testing for TB, malaria, HIV, hepatitis B & C, typhoid and other diseases common to the area.
